Extra credit: Jude condemns certain godless men who deny Jesus. He says that they are like Cain and Balaam and Korah.

- a) What is "the way of Cain?" See Genesis 4:1-12.
- b) What is "Balaam's error?" For the answer see Numbers 31:16. For the full story see Number 22:1-24:25 and Numbers 31:1-16.
- c) What is "Korah's rebellion?" See Numbers 16:1-3 (or read all of chapter 16 for the long version).

Extra credit: Jude is not the only New Testament writer to use Balaam as an example of someone wandering away from God. What other New Testament writer mentions Balaam?

Extra credit: Curious about Enoch? Read Genesis 5:21-24.
